2. Purpose of the tools

Note: as today, the tools are only available for iOS and for Secure Mail and Secure Web.

I created those tools to facilitate the modification of the Citrix Secure Apps: Secure Mail and Secure Web.

2.1 Why doing that?

In fact, I was asked by a customer who do not really like the Purple Theme of the Secure Apps if it was possible to modify the icon.

2.2 How does it work?

On launch, the tools create a temporary folder on your C:\ drive and download from Internet a specific file which is needed to rename the Apps.

After, you will be asked to provide some information:

- New Name of the App
- Source Image File (for Launch screen)
- Source Image File (for Word Mark)
- Source Image File (for the Icon)
- Source File (IPA file)
- Name for the destination folder

3. Run the tool

3.1 Prerequisite

On this first version, an Internet connection is needed to run the tools.

In fact, an encrypted XML file: info.plist need to be modified and to facilitate the process as I don't have enough knowledge to modify the encrypted file, I created a ZIP file containing the unencrypted version of those files.

On the first launch of the tools:

1. A directory will be created: C:\Temporary
2. The ZIP File will be download from Internet (in fact on my blog)

1. Double click on , the following window will appear

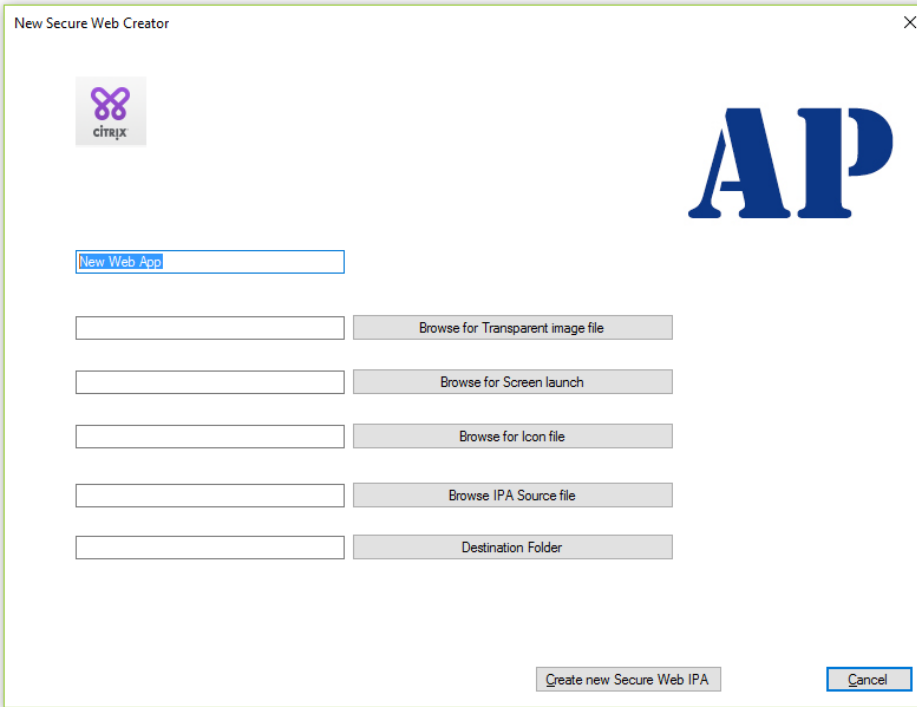

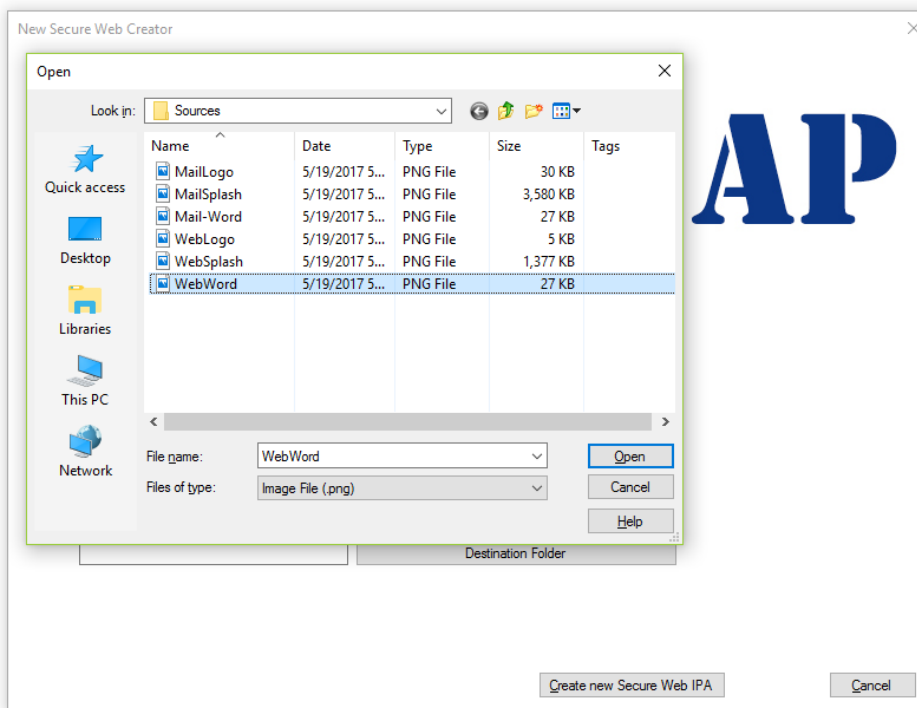

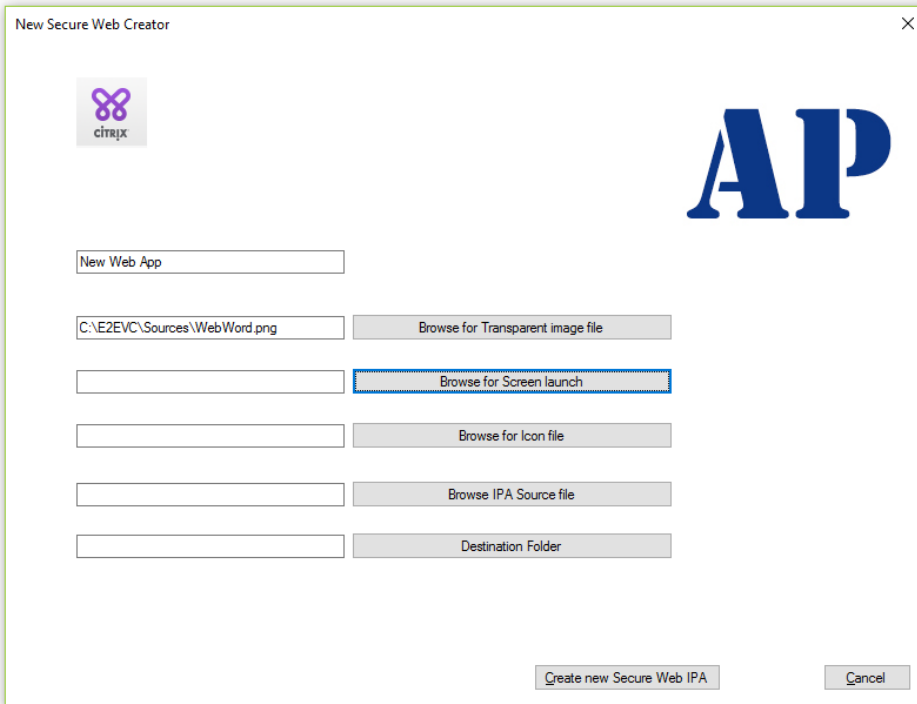
2. Provide the name you want for the new application



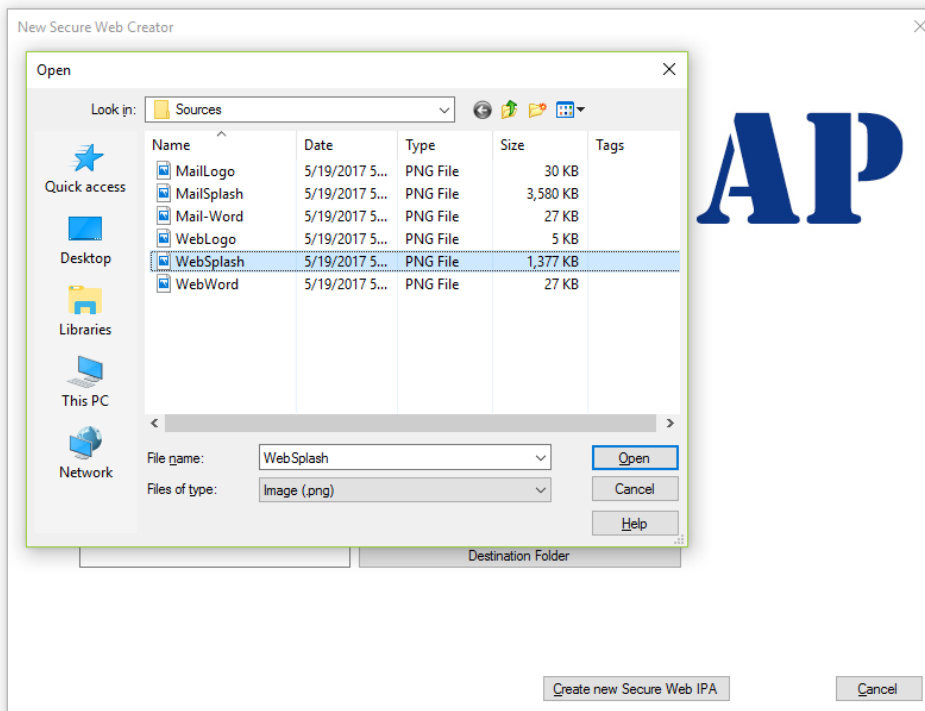
3. Click on **Browse for Transparent image file**



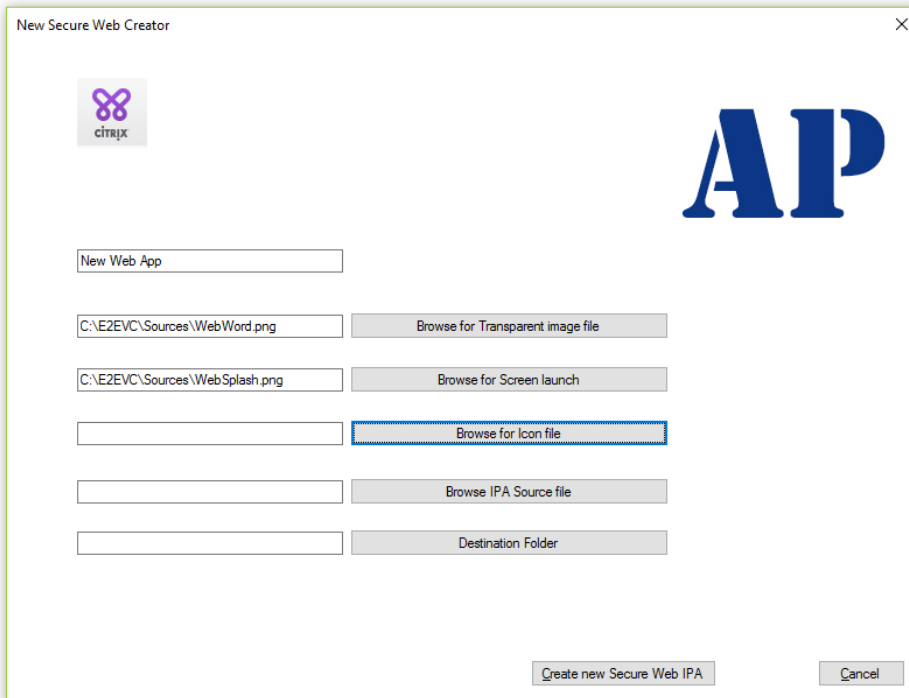
4. Select the file and click on **Open**



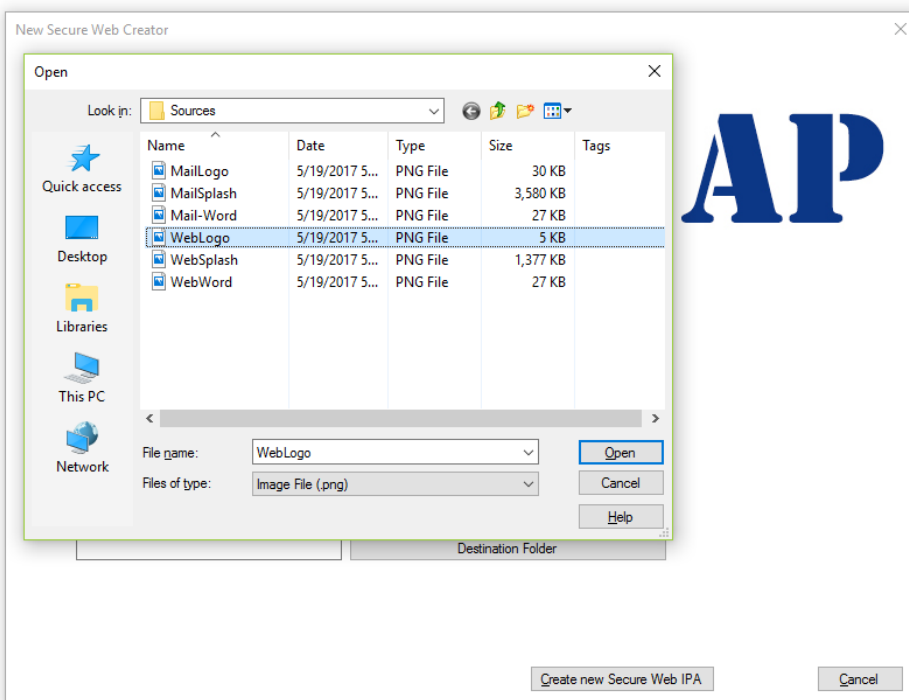
5. Click on **Browse for Screen launch**



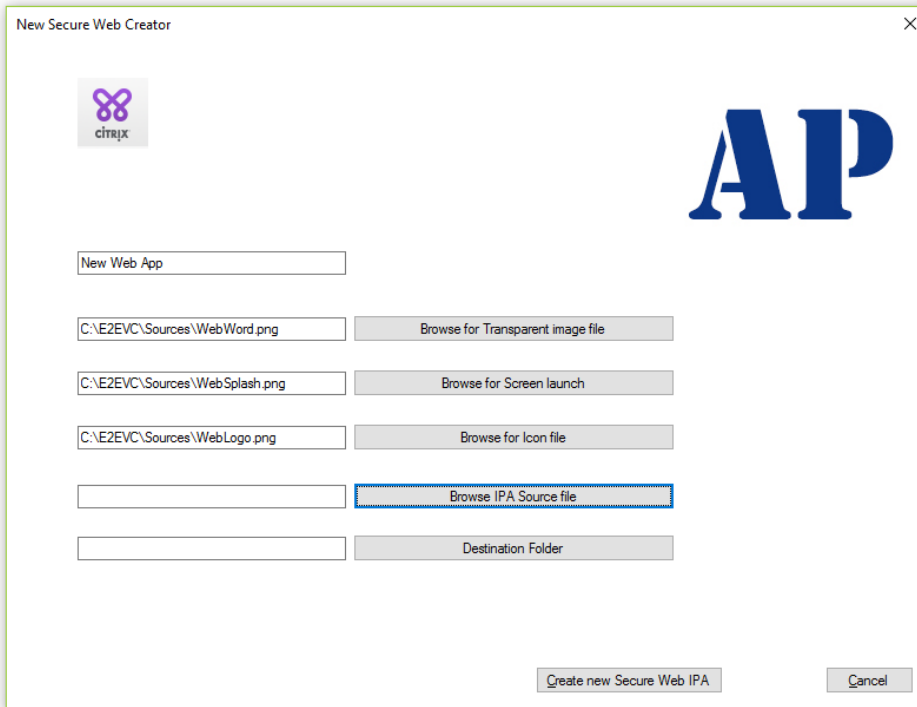
6. Select the file and click on **Open**



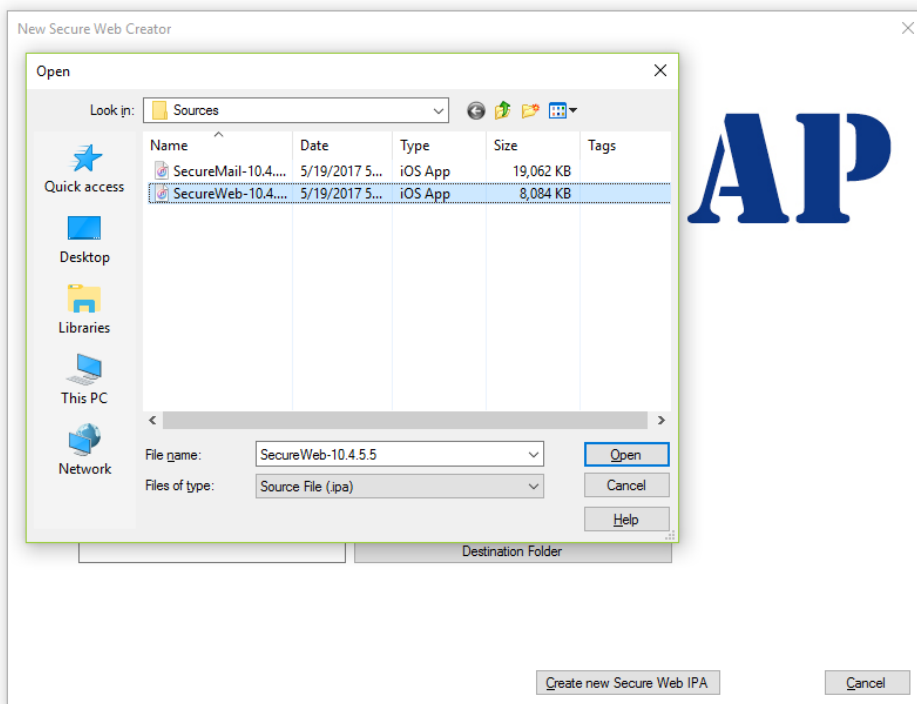
7. Click on **Browse for Icon file**



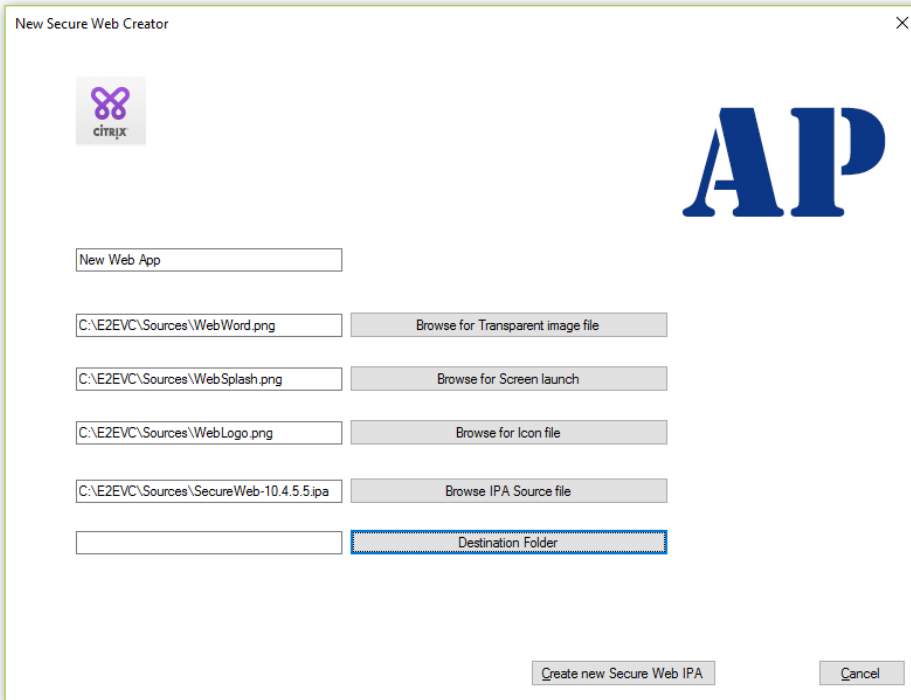
8. Select the image file and click on **Open**



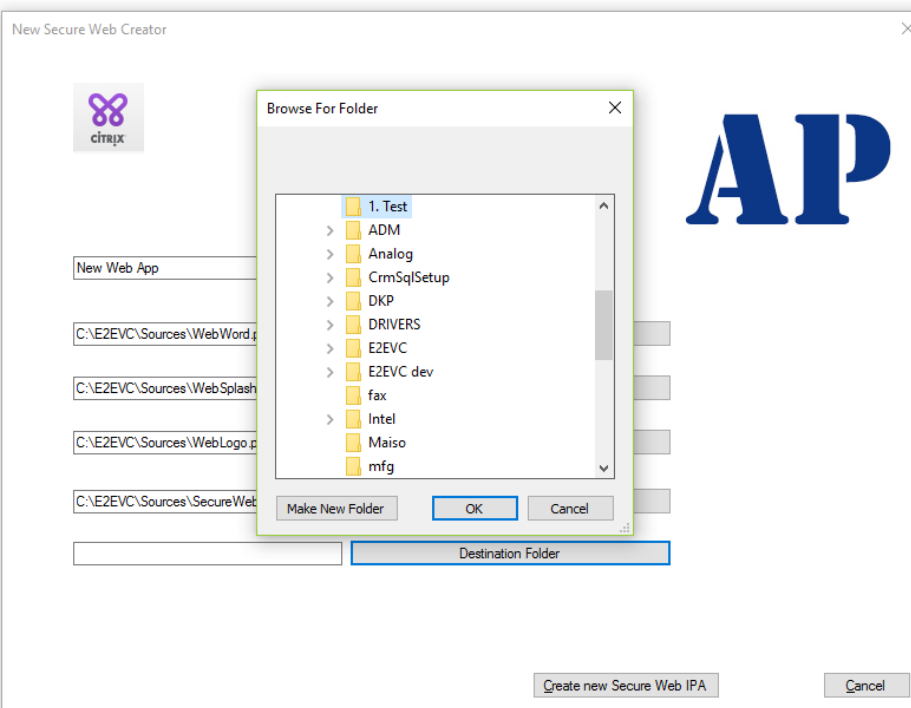
9. Click on **Browse for IPA Source file**



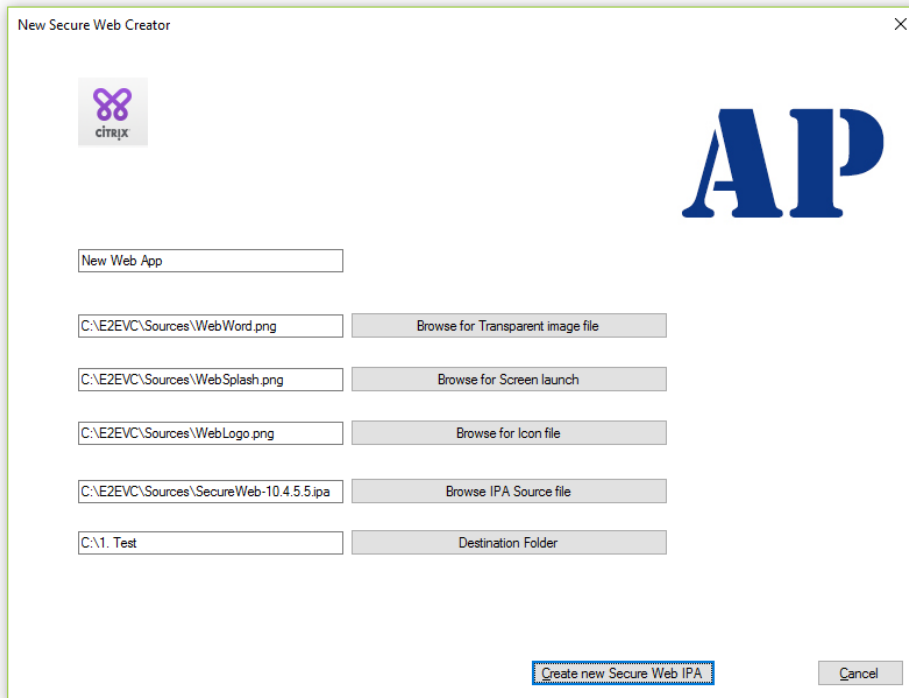
10. Select the source file, in this example SecureWeb and click on **Open**



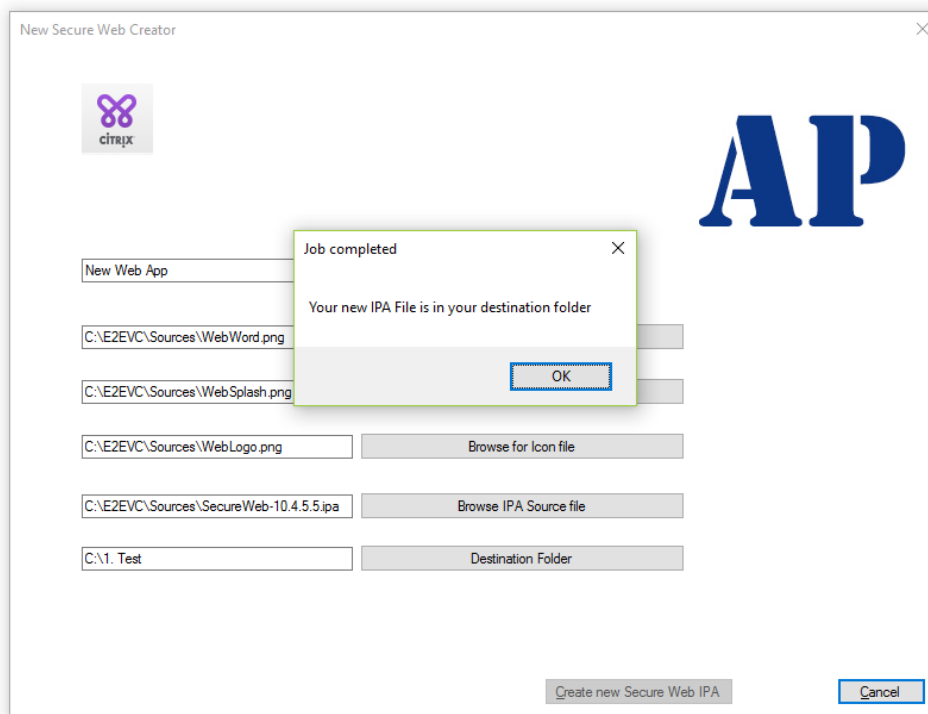
11. Click on **Destination Folder**



12. You can create a new folder or select an existing one and click on **OK**

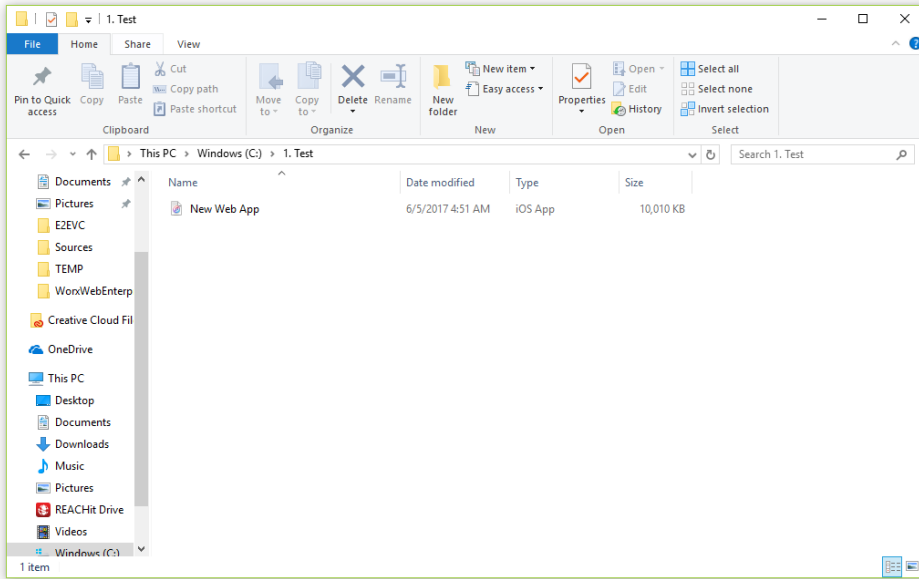


13. Click on **Create new Secure Web IPA**



14. Click on **OK**

The program is close and you can see you new IPA file in the folder:

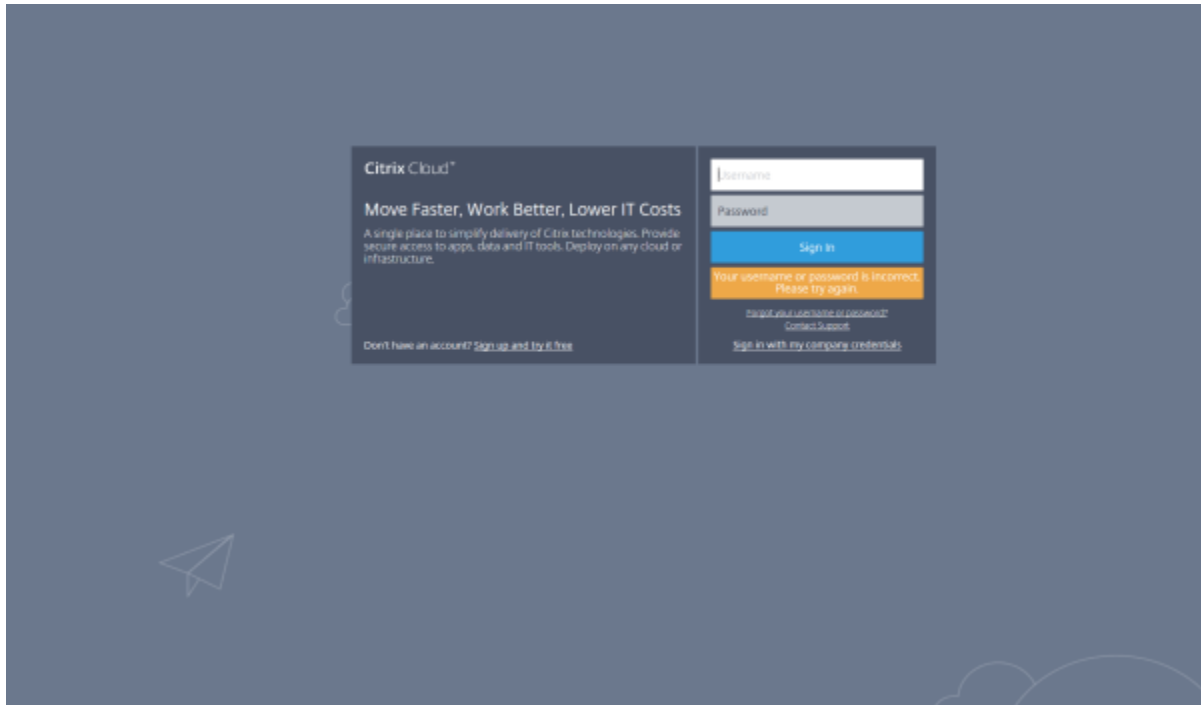


4. Wrap the file

Since end of 2016 it's possible to wrap an IPA without a Mac by using Citrix Cloud Service.

Here after the steps:

1. Connect to <https://mdx.xm.cloud.com>



2. Click on **Start**

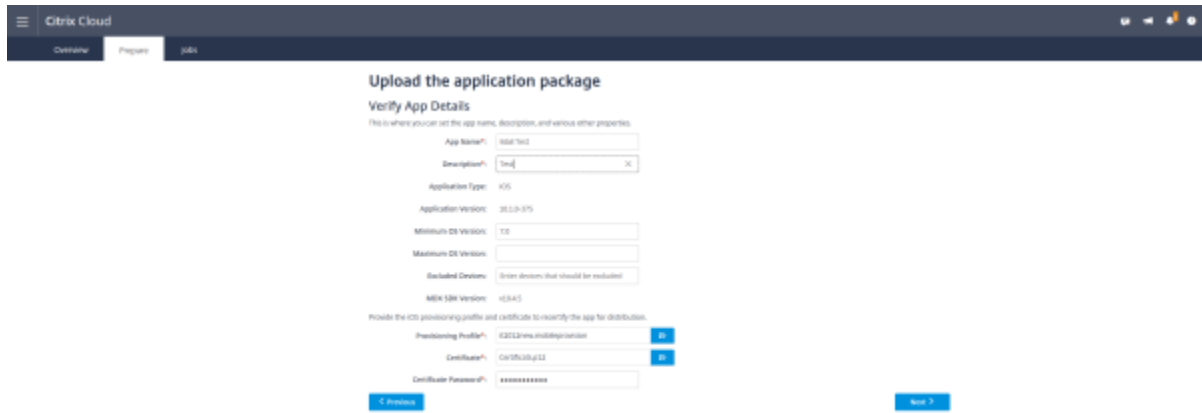


3. Upload the .IPA file

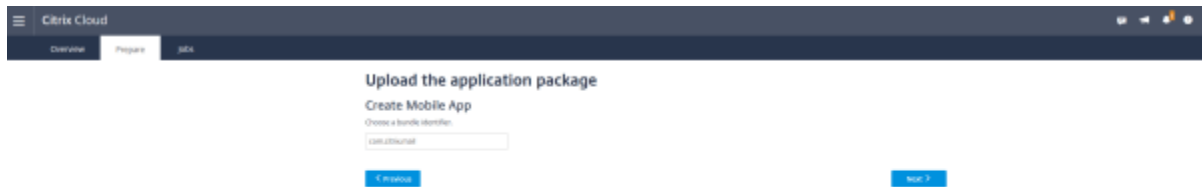


4. After successful upload of the file, a **Verify App Details** screen appear

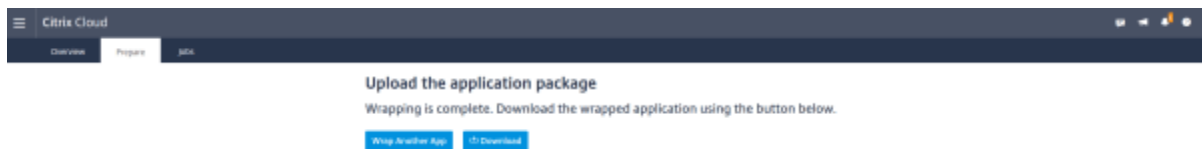
Verify the information, upload your **Provisioning Profile**, your **Certificate** and **Certificate Password** and click on **Next**



5. After the MDX services use the signing assets to modify the app, the **Create Mobile App** screen appears



6. Download the wrapped MDX application package (.mdx file)



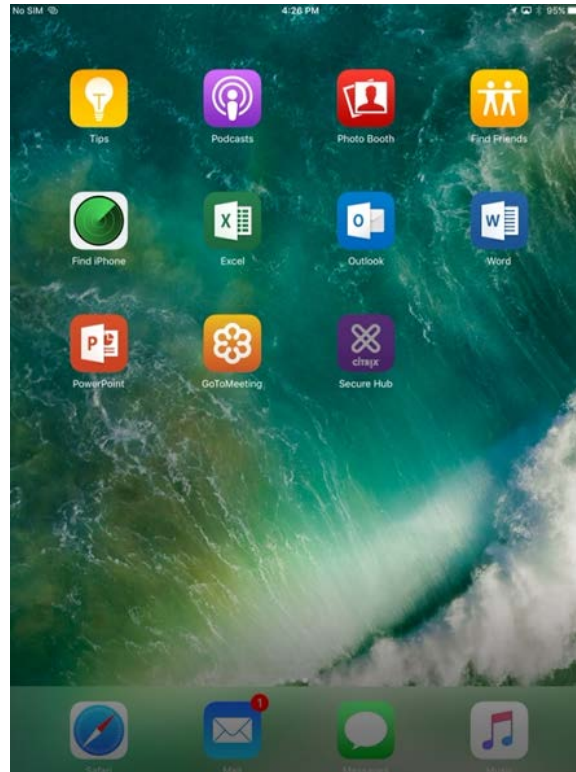
5. Upload the MDX

After the creation of the MDX File, the next step is to upload it on the XMS Server.

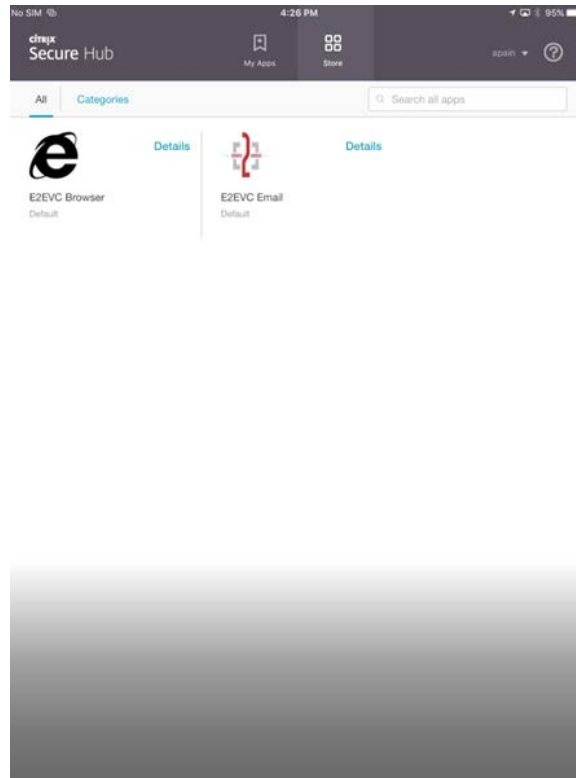
I will not explain here how to do it, I can imagine that everyone who is reading this document know how to do this.

6. Tests

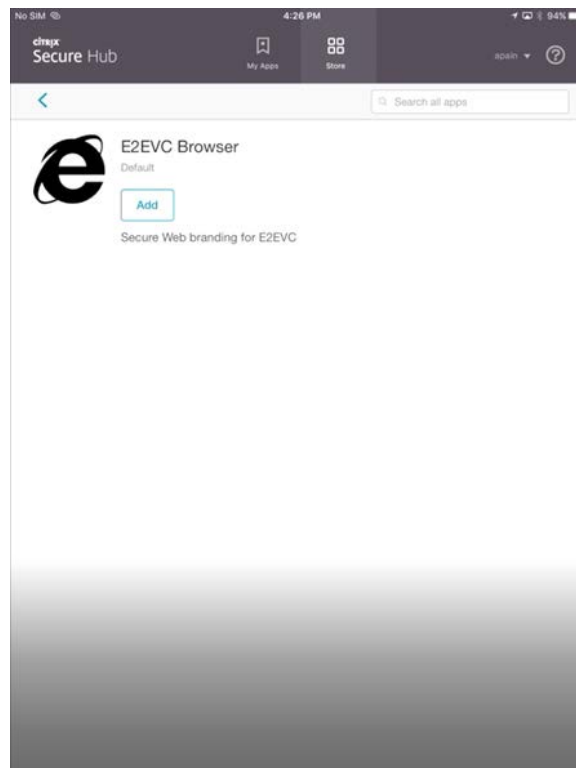
6.1 Download the MDX



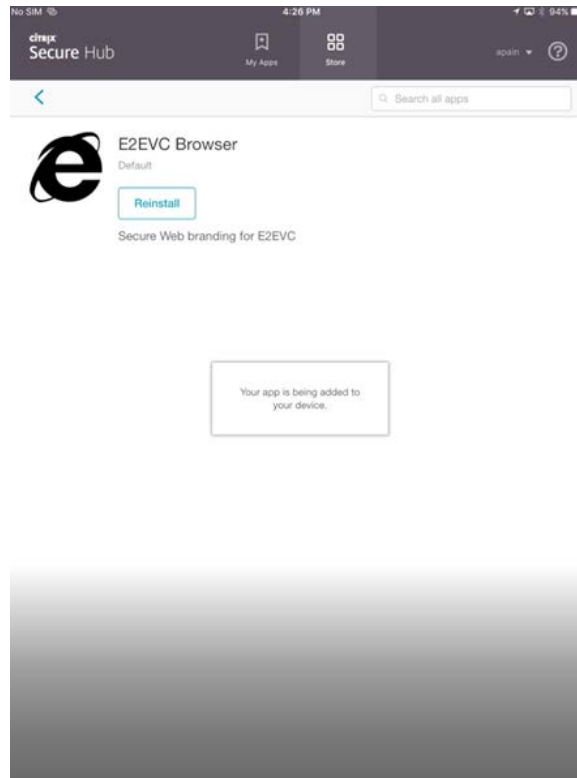
1. Open Secure Hub



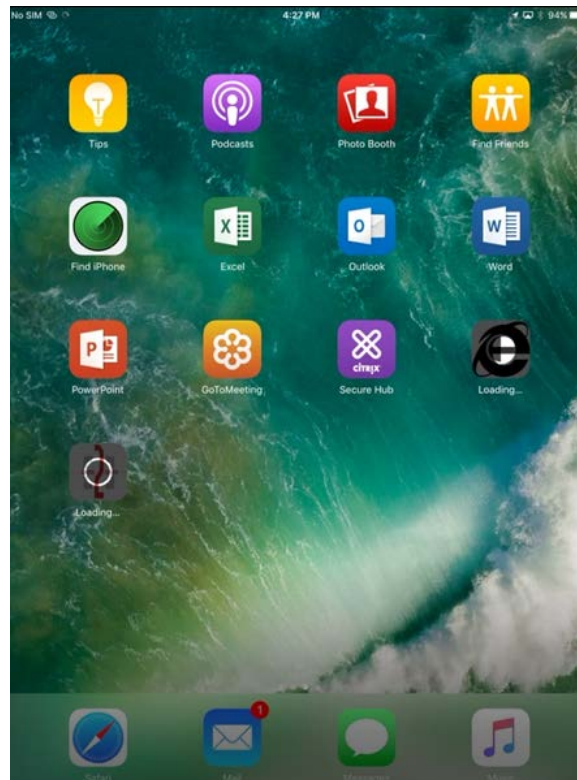
2. Tap on the New App (here in this example new Secure Web which name is E2EVC Browser)



3. Tap on **Add** to install the App

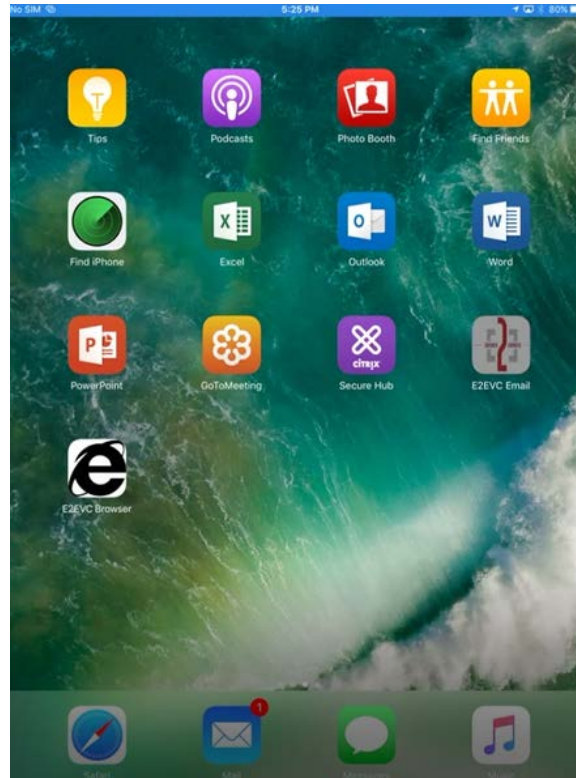


4. The App is installed on your device

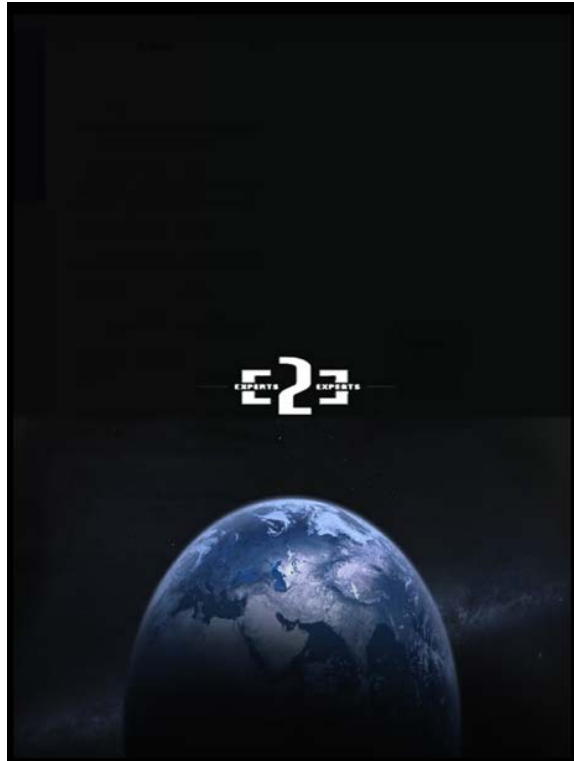


6.2 Open the MDX

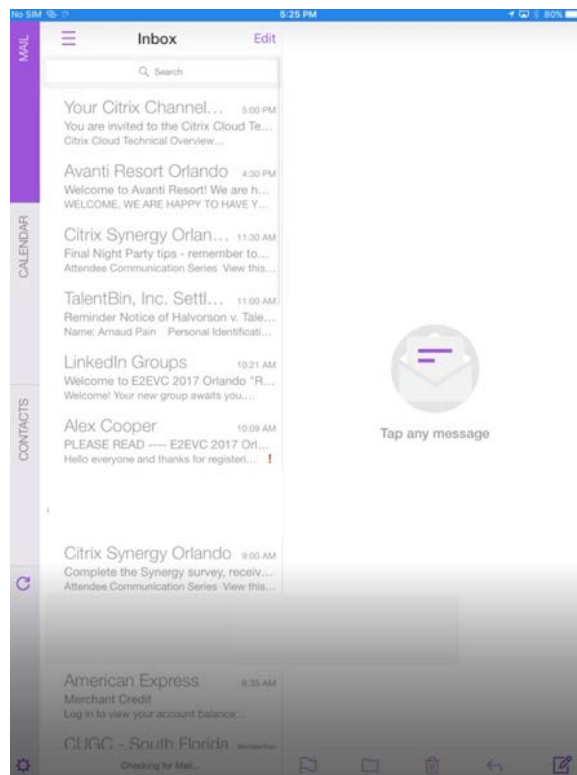
Note: We can see that name and icon appear as defined in the tool after installation.



1. Tap on the App to open it



2. Launch screen and Word mark appear as modified



7. Next Steps
